Dear Ms. Texeira:

In anticipation of the LAFCO hearing of June 11, 2008, Delta Diablo Sanitation District is submitting the following comments regarding the Municipal Service Review (MSR) and the Sphere of Influence (SOI) updates.

DDSD does not oppose LAFCO processing an update adjusting DDSD's SOI as part of the five year review period mandated by the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Government Reorganization Act of 2000, so that it is consistent with the approved Urban Limit Lines for both Antioch and Pittsburg. DDSD agrees to provide funds necessary for LAFCO to complete an Initial Study covering areas within existing City SOIs which are not presently part of DDSD's SOI. In addition, DDSD has no objection if another party wishes to provide the remaining funds necessary for the preparation of the expanded Initial Study to review an SOI adjustment that covers areas within the approved Urban Limit Lines of Antioch and Pittsburg.

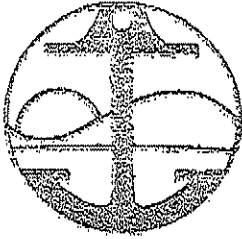


Dear Ms. Texeira:

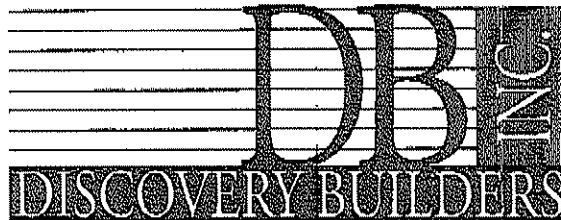


At the May 14th, 2008 Contra Costa County LAFCO hearing there was significant discussion by the LAFCO Board members related to the preparation and completion of an Initial Study to review Sphere of Influence expansions for DDSD and CCWD to make them coterminous with the Urban Limit Lines for both Antioch and Pittsburg. This item was continued to their June meeting.

At the May 14th hearing, the LAFCO Board members represented that they intend to direct LAFCO staff to complete the Initial Study provided that another source of funding is available to LAFCO to perform such work. At this meeting you, on behalf of the City of Pittsburg, agreed to assist LAFCO staff as another agency, in facilitating the completion of this Initial Study. Furthermore, at this meeting, I, on behalf of Discovery Builders, Inc., an interested third party, agreed to assist the City of Pittsburg and LAFCO staff, by providing the funding necessary to complete this Initial Study.

This letter reaffirms our funding commitment (subject to our review and approval of the consultant and its proposal for the scope of work). This commitment will allow the City of Pittsburg to further coordinate with LAFCO staff, ensuring that funding for the Initial Study (with LAFCO as the lead agency) will be provided.

Please let me know if you have any questions and please include us in any upcoming meetings with LAFCO staff. We expect the City to submit a letter to LAFCO immediately indicating that the funding has been secured, accompanied by DDSD's willingness to share in the costs, which will enable LAFCO to complete the Initial Study.
