1. Call to Order
2. Public Comment Period - This is an opportunity for members of the public to speak on items that are **not** on the agenda.
3. Protest Hearing – *LAFCO 21-11 – Annexation of East Contra Costa Fire Protection District (ECCFPD) to Contra Costa County Fire Protection District and Dissolution of ECCFPD* – This proposal was approved by the Contra Costa Local Agency Formation Commission on March 9, 2022, subject to the terms and conditions of LAFCO Resolution No. 21-11 and a protest hearing. **Public Hearing**

The LAFCO Executive Officer, as authorized by statute (Government Code section 57000 et seq.) and local policy, will conduct the protest hearing. The purpose of the protest hearing is to receive written protests regarding the CCCFPD/ECCFPD boundary reorganization. The LAFCO Executive Officer will conduct the protest hearing as follows:

1. Describe the proposal and purpose of the hearing.
2. Summarize LAFCO Resolution No. 21-11.
3. Open the hearing.
4. Receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence.
5. Note all written protests received before the hearing.
6. Close the hearing.
7. Determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn.

At the meeting, the Executive Officer will present the results of this protest hearing, with a draft resolution, to the Commission for its consideration.
