1. Call to Order
2. Public Comment Period - This is an opportunity for members of the public to speak on items that are **not** on the agenda.
3. Protest Hearing – *LAFCO 22-01 –Dissolution of Knightsen Town Community Services District (KTCSD)* – The dissolution proposal was initiated by the KTCSD Board of Directors on February 2, 2023 and approved by LAFCO on May 10, 2023, subject to terms and conditions included in LAFCO Resolution No. 23-01 and a protest hearing. **Public Hearing**

The LAFCO Executive Officer, as authorized by statute (Government Code section 57000 et seq.) and local policy, will conduct the protest hearing. The purpose of the protest hearing is to receive written protests regarding dissolution of KTCSD. The LAFCO Executive Officer will conduct the protest hearing as follows:

1. Describe the proposal and purpose of the hearing.
2. Summarize LAFCO Resolution No. 23-01.
3. Open the hearing.
4. Receive any oral or written protests, objections, or evidence.
5. Note all written protests received before the hearing.
6. Close the hearing.
7. Determine the value of written protests filed and not withdrawn.

The next regular LAFCO meeting is on June 14, 2023, at 1:30 pm at which time the Executive Officer will present to the Commission the results of the protest hearing along with a draft resolution for the Commission's consideration.
